These positions are an integral part of the Family Enhancement team and will work under the supervision of the Family Enhancement Manager. They will provide community based prevention and intervention services to children, youth, families and the community that are aimed at reducing those risk factors that may bring a child into care thereby helping to keep children safely in the home and to improve the quality of life.

The positions **will require** evening and weekend work and will be based primarily in the community.

Responsibilities will include:

1. Early Intervention: early identification of children, youth and families in need of services and the provision of effective service. Services may include, but not be limited to:
 - Assessment
 - Referral to specialized services
 - Liaison
 - Crisis intervention
 - Individual and family counselling
 - Advocacy and case management
2. Community Prevention and Intervention:
 - Community mobilization: working with community to identify community priorities, resources, needs and solutions;
 - Community participation: encouraging participation and/or volunteerism thereby inspiring communities to organize and take the initiative;
 - Assess the needs of various groups including children, youth, adults, and the elderly; men and women, people with disabilities; and
 - Community development: encourage, promote and build capacity and empower community members to come together to take action to generate solutions to issues affecting the community.
3. Program Implementation: project leadership in the action plan developed with community and may include:
 - Group facilitation
 - Support groups
 - Awareness programs
 - Collaboration with community service providers
 - Recreation programs

- Certification in Addictions, Community Development or Youth Care Worker; Community Wellness Worker, Mental Health and Wellness, and/or equivalent.
- A minimum of two years' experience with working with children, youth, and families.
- Several years' experience working with crisis intervention, counselling, support groups.
