Special Constables would assist the Cut Knife, Poundmaker, Little Pine RCMP detachment if approved under the proposed justice agreement.

The overall security and safety of the two nations needs to be enhanced. The RCMP currently have the mandate to provide this service. This training program will develop a pool of qualified people to be employed as special constables under the anticipated justice agreement to assist and enhance the delivery of the service.

The successful applicants for training will possess excellent interpersonal, written and oral communication skills with proven relationship building abilities.

- Age 18 or Older
- Grade 12 or Equivalencies considered
- Class 5 Saskatchewan full driver's license with current abstract insurable under our commercial auto policy
- Satisfactory medical and vision
- A criminal record check, no outstanding criminal charges and is not subject of a criminal investigation
- Must pass drug testing
- Current Standard First Aid, Level C CPR and AED certification
- Computer experience with Microsoft Windows based systems and Microsoft applications
- Three (3) reference letters attesting to your character
