### Program Overview

The SIIT Home Builder program is designed to provide students with experience of building a complete home. The program will develop the basic skills needed for entry-level work in residential or commercial construction. Students will develop skills in key aspects of house construction, job readiness, construction math, and safety. Students will also develop a good understanding of the Saskatchewan Apprenticeship system and the benefits of trade certification.
